

HIGHLIGHTS OF CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS

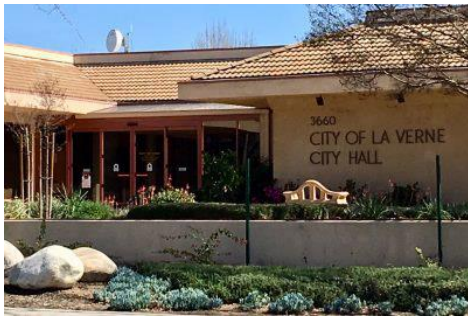
At the October meetings, the City Council:

City Manager & Public Works Director Developments



Council has begun interviewing qualified applicants for the City Manager position and has narrowed it to a select few candidates. Council is expected to appoint a permanent City Manager before the end of December. The City is pleased at the number of applicants the Public Works Director position has received and expect interviews to start later in the year.

Election Information

The City of La Verne has multiple voting centers available for residents to vote at in the upcoming November 8th General Election. Ballot drop-off boxes are open for residents at Oak Mesa Park, 5400 Wheeler Avenue, and at La Verne City Hall, 3660 D Street. These boxes are open 24 hours a day leading up to election day and will be locked at 8:00 PM on November 8th.

In-person voting centers in La Verne will be open from November 5th to the 8th at St. Johns Episcopal Church, 4745 Wheeler Avenue, and at the University of La Verne, 2000 2nd Street. From November 5th to the 7th, the centers will be open from 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM and then on November 8th from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM.

PUBLIC WORKS

Annual Inspections



As we close out 2022, the Public Works Department has hired a consultant to conduct mandatory inspections of specific business to meet the requirements of Senate Bill 1383 (organic recycling) and Order Number R4-2021-0105. Our consultant will be visiting Tier 1 businesses, large food generating businesses such as grocery stores, food makers like Madi K's Chocolates, University of La Verne, and Gilead to ensure that they are recycling organics, donating edible food and more, while keeping records of these activities.



Stormwater inspections will be consistent with previous years but changed slightly to reflect the new requirements from the updated permit, stormwater permit Order Number R4-2021-0105 from the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, LA Region. City staff felt it important to minimize business disruptions, therefore we combined the inspections.

Due to grant funds for both of those inspections, the City will not have to charge the businesses to comply with State laws.

Street Improvements

Over the past year, the Public Works Department has planned, designed, and begun construction on various streets across the City. La Verne's road conditions are among the highest rated in Los Angeles County with most roads in "Good" or "Very Good" condition. The Public Works Department will continue rehabilitating streets throughout the City and anticipates implementing upgrades to two of La Verne's major thoroughfares in 2023 and is expected to extend into 2024. The first project will repave segments of 6th Street, Bonita Avenue, Moss Circle and connecting streets, while the second project will repave White Avenue from Foothill Boulevard to Arrow Highway.



Hazardous Waste Event

Brackett Airport will be hosting a hazardous waste pick up event on Saturday, December 17th from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. They will be accepting paint, assorted household chemicals such as cleaners, and more. Any product labeled toxic, poisonous, combustible, corrosive, flammable, or irritant can be disposed of at this site.
