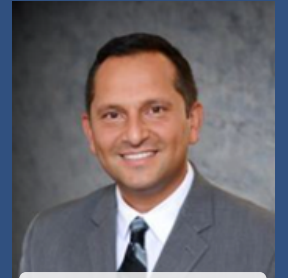

Retired Senior Volunteer Patrol 2025 Report

2025 was a year of growth and transition for the La Verne Police Department's Retired Senior Volunteer Patrol (RSVP). The team logged 6,505 volunteer hours with 25 members, welcomed three new volunteers, and updated its Operations Manual to support ongoing training. RSVP provided 239 vacation house checks, assisted with traffic control, court runs, and crossing guard coverage, and completed 769 Livescans and 80 ink cards, while also supporting records operations. The You Are Not Alone program delivered nearly 500 hours of outreach to residents, receiving positive feedback from participants and families. Want to get involved? Gold Spotted Oak Borer - Marshall Canyon

The City has been notified by the Los Angeles County Department of Parks and Recreation and the Agricultural Commissioner of a significant infestation of the Gold Spotted Oak Borer, a pest that can kill oak trees and is primarily spread through the movement of infected wood, residents are urged not to transport firewood. In the coming weeks, County crews will work in and around Marshall Canyon to remove hazardous trees and treat affected oaks, and while the trail will remain open, visitors should use caution near active work areas. Mosquito Prevention Resources

Mosquito season is here, and a few simple steps can go a long way in protecting your home and community. During California Mosquito Awareness Week (April 14 to 18), and throughout the year, residents are encouraged to stay informed and take action to reduce mosquito activity. Eliminate standing water around your property (such as in planters, buckets, and gutters), use insect repellent when spending time outdoors, and make sure window and door screens are in good condition. Since mosquitoes can breed in as little as a bottle cap of water, staying proactive is key.
