

# WEDNESDAY WRAP UP JANUARY 21 MEETING



## CITY COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY

At the January 21, 2025 City Council Meeting, the La Verne City Council:

- Recognized the Christmas Morning volunteers;
- Received the results of the Community Survey and discussed how these results impact future planning. Visit [cityoflaverne.org/survey](http://cityoflaverne.org/survey) to see the results;
- Received a presentation regarding recycling and organics waste compliance requirements for commercial and multi-family residential properties;
- Approved on Consent the December 16 City Council Meeting minutes, the Register of Audited Demands, amendments to the eligible employee list for CalOES emergency incidents, salary adjustments for ambulance operators due to the increase in California Minimum Wage, a license agreement with Lewis Land Developers for recreation activities at the Lutheran High School Property, and a proclamation declaring the existence of a local emergency for the recent windstorms;
- Approved the Community Development Block Grant program for fiscal year 25-26;
- Adopted and certified the Environmental Impact Report for the General Plan and approved the General Plan Update;
- Approved the outdoor sidewalk dining and furniture policy;
- Rejected bids for the public works contract for video camera installation throughout the City, directing staff to rebid the project;
- Approved a contract with CentralSquare for the purchase of an upgraded Enterprise Resource Planning System and continue the contract with Naviline System for Utility Billing and Business License modules; and
- Approved the amended employment agreement between the City of La Verne and City Manager Ken Domer.
